The École Supérieure d'Art et Design Le Havre-Rouen (ésadhar) is a public institution of higher education in art, design and creative writing in Normandy, located along the Seine river and easily accessible by train from Paris.

ésadhar provides full training in art and design to around 300 students, and gives them access to a wide range of creative fields: painting, sculpture, installation,photography, video, performance, creative writing, screen printing, graphic design, typography, VR, interactive design, etc.

The courses are taught by actively practicing artists, designers, writers, andacademics. ésadhar takes an active part in numerous joint ventures with local, national and international partners, offering professional opportunities from year one. Students have access to technical workshops run by highly trained technicians, and to a designated workspace in a shared studio. The school also features a professional exhibition. space showcasing works by internationally renowned artists and graphic designers.

ésadhar provides a multilingual and international study environment. As part of the Erasmus+ program, the school welcomes incoming students for exchange programs. ésadhar's numerous partnerships, in Europe and worldwide, offer the possibility for its students to take part in international experiences.
